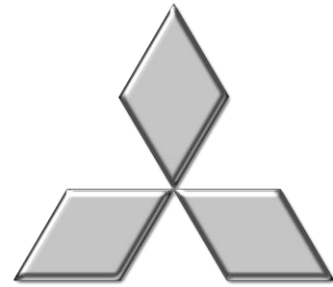

## Your Mitsubishi warranty guidelines

### How long does Mitsubishi's warranty last?

Mitsubishi's new car warranty is for five years from the original registration date or 62,500 miles, whichever is soonest. Subject to Mitsubishi's terms and conditions, warrants that any of the "Basic Warranty Items" of the new vehicle manufactured by or for Mitsubishi shall be free from any defects in material or workmanship under normal use, provided that correct maintenance has been carried out.

Any of the basic warranty items covered by this new vehicle warranty will be repaired or replaced free of charge by any authorised Mitsubishi Dealership within the warranty period.

*\* Outlander PHEV has an 8 Years/100,000 miles traction battery warranty.*

### What should I do if my car shows any defects within the warranty period?

Contact your local authorised Mitsubishi dealer immediately.

### What could make my warranty invalid?

Mitsubishi has a list of warranty exclusions, please see their warranty terms and conditions for information.

## **What are the service requirements to keep my warranty valid?**

You must have your car serviced within Mitsubishi's recommendations and have the details recorded within the Service Portfolio or in the Mitsubishi Digital Service Record system.

Mitsubishi recommends you use their authorised dealers for services and genuine Mitsubishi parts must be used for services and repairs. Recommended service intervals vary across models – please refer to your maintenance booklet for specific detail.

You should keep original invoices as evidence your car has been serviced in line with Mitsubishi's recommendations.

You should maintain the body and paintwork of your car in line with Mitsubishi's recommendations.
