The Honda warranty guidelines

How long does Honda's warranty last?

Honda's new car warranty is for three years from the original registration date or 90,000 miles, whichever is soonest.

What should I do if my car shows any defects within the warranty period?

Contact your local Authorised Honda dealer immediately and take your Service Book with you when you visit.

What could make my warranty invalid?

If your car has exceeded the stated mileage.

Damage or defect to your car caused by poor or insufficient servicing or maintenance won't be covered by the warranty.

If you've modified or altered your car, including conversions to alternative fuel, the warranty may be invalidated.

Defects due to the use of parts which do not meet the standards and specifications of genuine Honda parts, accessories, and lubricants or because of the neglect, mistreatment or use beyond the limitations or specifications of Honda (e.g. maximum load, passenger capacity etc.).

Defects due to the use of abrasive or aggressive cleaning materials on the car.

What are the service requirements to keep my warranty valid?

Your car needs to be serviced within Honda's specifications as. Recommended service intervals vary across models – please refer to your maintenance booklet for specific detail.
