## The Hyundai warranty guidelines

### How long does Hyundai's warranty last?

Hyundai's new car warranty is for five years, with unlimited mileage from the date of original registration. Also included are five years' Roadside Assistance Programme (from the date of original registration), Annual Vehicle Health Checks and ten or twelve year (dependent on model) Anti-Perforation Warranty (from the date of original registration) against perforation of the bodywork from the inside of the panel outwards.

### What should I do if my car shows any defects within the warranty period?

Contact your local Authorised Hyundai Repairer who will inspect your car and confirm whether the fault found is covered.

**What could make my warranty invalid?**

Damage or defect to your car caused by poor or insufficient servicing won't be covered by the warranty.

Any unapproved modifications or installations carried out outside the scope of normal routine maintenance.

Defects occurring because of careless handling or negligence, accident, improper use of the car, incorrectly completed repairs or the use of non-genuine Hyundai parts or accessories not approved by Hyundai will not be covered by the warranty.

**What are the service requirements to keep my warranty valid?**

Recommended service intervals vary across different models – please refer to your maintenance booklet for specific detail.
